ABOUT THE DPS

The Deltic Preservation Society (DPS) was formed in 1977 by a small group of enthusiasts with the aim of preserving a Deltic locomotive.

In 1982, the ambition was achieved with the purchase of 55009 *Alycidon* and 55019 *Royal Highland Fusilier*. A further purchase was made in 1986, with the Society acquiring 55015 *Tulyar* and No.2 end cab of 55008 *The Green Howards*.

In 1991 the Society became a company limited by guarantee and in 2003 became a registered charity. 2003 also saw the DPS build a purpose-built Depot, in which to house the locomotives, at Barrow Hill Roundhouse, Staveley, Chesterfield.

55009 Alycidon

55009 was purchased by the DPS for a sum of £16,550.09 + VAT from British Railways in 1982. Under the DPS's ownership the locomotive has undertaken a



mixture of Heritage Railways and Main Line workings. In recent years the locomotive has continued with a mixture of workings with a Main Line return in 2012 and a repaint from two-tone green to BR Blue in Spring

D9015 Tulyar

D9015 was purchased by the DPS in 1986 and ran on Heritage Railways up until 1997 when the locomotive was withdrawn for a major overhaul.

With the bodysides replaced, an electrical rewire, and overhaul and rebuild of all systems, D9015 is approaching the end of its major overhaul.



55019 Royal Highland Fusilier

Under the DPS's ownership the locomotive has undertaken a mixture of Heritage Railways and Main Line workings, with the locomotives Main Line career coming to an end in 2005.

The DPS are currently working towards returning 55019 to the Main Line. In the meantime, 55019 will continue to operate on Heritage Railways across the country.



55008's Cab & Display

The refurbished Cab of 55008 sits in the corner of the DPS Depot for visitors to enjoy and experience inside a Deltic Cab. Accompanying the Cab is a display featuring the history of the surviving class members.



WHY WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT

Our Deltics are now over 60 years old and need constant care to keep them operating. We rely heavily on our members and supporters to assist us.

GIFT AID

What does this mean? Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, either as a donation or as part of your annual membership subscription, we can claim the equivalent of 25 pence back in tax from HM Revenue & Customs.

What is this worth to the DPS? A £10 pound donation can be turned into £12.50. A typical annual membership subscription of £25 can be turned into £28.13

Does it cost me anything? Absolutely nothing.

Am I eligible? To be eligible you must be a UK taxpayer and pay an amount of tax at least equal to the amount of tax we reclaim on your donation/subscription in the tax year.

Is it simpler? Yes, all you have to do is tick the box on the membership form, and that's it!
